<p>Application materials to be provided</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Letter of recommendation • Application form signed by your home institution • Résumé or CV • Most recent grade transcripts in either French or English • Copy of official ID papers (passport for non-EU students, ID card) • Proof of language proficiency • Learning agreement validated by home institution • Health insurance certificate or European Health Insurance Card <p>A certified copy of your birth certificate in French or English is required by the French administration giving housing benefits (depends on your kind of visa).</p>								
<p>Work placement/internship</p>	<p>A work placement/internship is possible only if the student has the necessary language level to work in a French-speaking environment.</p> <p>Students must contact the host department or company directly. ESCEM does not organize Erasmus or any other internship training.</p>								
<p>French language classes</p>	<p>French language classes are mandatory for all exchange students (no fee).</p>								
<p>Immigration</p>	<p>All Non-European students must have a valid visa, which must cover the whole period of study at ESCEM. An acceptance letter will be emailed to students and a hard copy sent to home universities in order to start visa application.</p>								
<p>Health care</p>	<p>EU students: must obtain a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) and supply a copy on arrival.</p> <p>Non-EU students: Health insurance is mandatory. On arrival, you will get all the information to sign up to French Health insurance (CPAM), if you wish to do so.</p>								
<p>Computer services</p>	<p>All students are given an ESCEM e-mail address on arrival, as well as passwords to access the campus Wi-Fi.</p>								
<p>Insurance</p>	<p>ESCEM assumes NO LIABILITY for any costs if a student is not properly insured.</p> <p>All students must be covered for medical repatriation and civil liability.</p>								
<p>Accommodation</p>	<p>ESCEM accompanies incoming students through the process of application to state-owned residences (CROUS administration). Students can choose rooms from a range of prices (from €224 to €355 per month)* depending on the residence and the type of room. *Prices updated up to June 2020</p>
